Onion-shaped domes, multi-foil arches, paired pilasters, in-lay work, frescoes, etc. are of Mughal extraction, more specially of Shah Jahan's period, while oriel windows, bracket supported eaves at the string-course, chattris, richly ornamented friezes, etc., are derived from elements of Rajput architecture such as is seen in Jaipur, Jodhpur, Bikaner and other places in Rajasthan.

openings, wooden fenestrations, iron railings, wall frescos and elaborately carved wooden brackets (commonly found in the havelis of Ahmedabad). These architectural features are from Mughal, Sikh and Hindu and even Indo-British features. I've been admiring these buildings since my childhood.
