Aperture. The size of this opening, or aperture, is usually indicated in f-numbers 1.4, 2, 2.8, 4, 5.6, 8, 11, 16, 22 and 32. The larger the number, the smaller the opening. On most lenses for 35mm cameras, the smallest aperture is f/16, f/22. The largest aperture varies, but on most models, it is at least f/2.8.

A 50 mm lens has a limit of 1/60th of a second, and a 300 mm lens has a 1/250-1/300 range. IM allows you to bring this setting down to something more friendly. Some cameras, such as the Canon R mirrorless have image stabilization built-into the camera. This turns every one of your lenses into a stabilized eye.
